## Carpenter's Wheel: Full Day Workshop

**Description:** Oh my stars and cubes! Fun shapes that all come together for this old time favorite. Learn to master the "Butterfly Seam", it's a snap...enjoy the magic of effortless precision piecing. The illusion of difficult made easy. Plan to finish this as a wall hanging or the center of a medallion quilt. Create the surprise of a perfectly pieced border, I promise!

## Fabric Requirements:

Fabric A: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard for accent squares and 45° diamonds Fabric B: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard for QST, 45° diamonds and border Background Fabric: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard for QST, squares and triangles <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yard for binding 1 yard backing and craft size batting

Special tools: Ruler with 45 degree marking and Angle Trim Tool (\$15)

**Instructions**: Pattern (\$10)

## **General supplies:**

Sewing machine with manual (are machines provided?); <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" foot without edge guide (if possible); (2) thread colors, one for the top and another in the bobbin and that is visible on the wrong side of fabric; seam ripper; thread snips; rotary cutter, 6" x 18" ruler and mat; straight pins; extension cord; straight pins; finger pressing tool; and batting to use as a design wall (optional).

**Gyleen's thoughts**: The center star is a classic Lemoyne Star. Select fabric that will make the star take center stage. As for the background, go for it. If you're just making a wall hanging keep the fabrics scale small to medium.
