

## Over and Under Rainbows – Half day workshop

**Description:** Modern with a twist! "KNOT" as hard as you think! It's visually dynamic with fast easy piecing. Don't let cutting "Tie" you up. All you need is one 2.5" strip set and 3.5 yards of background.

### Fabric Requirements:

(42) 2½" x 40" strips, assorted colors (solids, semi-solids, batiks)  
3½ yards background fabric (note: 4 yards of background fabric is needed if you want a border.)

**Homework:** Cut (12) 2½" x 40" strips from background fabric.

**Special Tool:** Angle Trim Tool

**Instructions:** Pattern

### General Supplies:

Sewing machine with manual; ¼" foot without edge guide (if possible); (2) thread colors, one for the top and another in the bobbin and that is visible on the wrong side of fabric; seam ripper; thread snips; rotary cutter, ruler and mat; extension cord; straight pins; finger pressing tool; and batting to use as a design wall (optional).

**Gyleen's thoughts:** Workshop project is a 70" x 70" lap quilt, however doing less makes a wonderful table or bed runner. Project looks modern with solid or semi-solid or batik fabric. Select a background fabric that doesn't compete with your strips. If you have a collection of self-made 2½ strips you go for scrappy. I used my light 2½ strips for a scrappy background. Don't over think it. Come to have fun.
