

So Square: Full Day Workshop

Description: Relaxing, is the one word that describes the half-day of piecing a graphic beauty. Never be afraid of pinwheels again, come learn the easy way to get perfect points! Plan to use your stash or start with pre-cuts. You choose the final size.

Fabric requirements:

(15-20) 6½” X 40” strips, assorted colors

(15-20) 3½” X 22” strips, assorted colors

1 yard for sashing and binding

Homework:

Cut (18) 6½” x 9½”; (40) 6½” x 6½”; bring remaining fabric to class.

Cut (36) 3½” x 3½”; bring remaining fabric to class.

Special tool: Angle Trim Tool

Instructions: Pattern, \$10 or Book – Bricks, Cobblestones, and Pebbles, \$30

General supplies:

Sewing machine with manual; ¼” foot without edge guide (if possible); (2) thread colors, one for the top and another in the bobbin and that is visible on the wrong side of fabric; seam ripper; thread snips; rotary cutter, ruler and mat; extension cord; straight pins; and batting to use as a design wall (optional).

Gyleen’s thoughts: Graphic and modern with cleanliness. Squares and rectangles do the work for a visually stunning quilt. This is a great design for solids, semi-solids, and batiks. But wait, there’s more! This same design can be scrappy to use your pre-cuts. A two for one option!
