## Wisp/City Scape – Full Day Workshop

**Description:** Diamonds create gentle watercolor movement for a modern lap quilt. It's the perfect design to show off machine quilting. And it's pre-cut friendly! 1 Jelly Roll and 1 yard of focus fabric. Change your view to the sea, woods or landscape just by changing your fabric selection.

## **Fabric Requirements:**

(42) 2 ½" x 40" strips batik fabric or (1) 42 pieced jelly roll 1 yard of Soloist fabric, the fabric the just sings 1 yard for setting triangles and binding

Special tools: Polygon2 Tool (\$20)

**Instructions** – Pattern (\$10)

## General supplies:

Sewing machine with manual; <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" foot without edge guide (if possible); (2) thread colors, one for the top and another in the bobbin and that is visible on the wrong side of fabric; seam ripper; thread snips; rotary cutter, ruler and mat; extension cord; straight pins; finger pressing tool; and batting to use as a design wall (optional).

Gyleen's thoughts: Fabric-wise this project can read like a watercolor because I used batik. Certainly, you can use another type of fabric and it would be fun to use solids as well. You probably could even do this scrappy with just a little extra thought.
